
Distribution of univ. oversight all under Ministry of Education. This is a change from days when each ministry had univ that they drew workers from (i.e. Transportation, Culture, etc.).

Chinese prop. had taught emphasis on western culture, but more recently there is an effort to examine eastern culture more.

In certain rural populations all the men go to the big cities to work. This causes problems in the resident system. Need a red card in order to register for local schools. If you work for a place that does not offer a hukou (resident permit to register for a local school).

Chinese Legal Reform and its Prospect
was a worker in cultural revolution and an elem. sch. teacher. As a worker he worked in a military factory producing grenades. It was moved into a rural area where there was no school for the children so he was transferred to teach.

During CR red guard organized by students criticized the teachers. 2 of his colleagues died. 1 committed suicide w/ her husband. She could not take the humiliation. The other died in custody. After being sent to teach for 4 years he was sent to univ. to study. ~~After~~ CR there was no class, no law.

During
In Univ. he studied law because his science + math was cut off by the CR, + he cd. not enter into economics or science. At the time there were only 7 areas of law:

pop. 1.3 B annual growth 0.6%
life expectancy 70.8 yrs.
fertility rate 1.9 births/woman
infant mortality 30.0/1000 live births.

China has large problem of uneven economic development
east vs west

sustainable development nationally a big topic in international affairs. China claims it is still a developing nation so that they can get aid from the World Bank.

Rule of law is the foundation for getting support from world Bank.



China model of development has been called Beijing consensus considers foreign investment combined w/ native (local) conditions.

Different from US investment which is open/free market

Chinese has macro control. A well regulated market. Gov't has a 5-yr plan which has legal controls

First wave of development based on legal advice from US - but there was no root change in the legal culture.

Second wave was privatization lead by Reagan + Thatcher.

Now it is based on your own character of national culture and collectivism. State ownership is the backbone of the economy.

Chinese proverb - the law never punishes the group.

Chinese reforms are incremental. There is tension between judicial independence and the legal system.

"Only reform can save China." "Every reform must have a legal ground." The great task is to unify all the country. China needs to develop a social welfare system.

The Chinese way is to seek truth through facts.

GAOKAO

1997 He took his gaokao most unforgettable of his life. Went to Shandong H.S. grew up in N. China plains - passing means changing his life away from labor + farmland + repeating the destiny of his father + grandfather. It gives an open horizon for the future. He had prepared for the exam. Usually the study day ends @ 10 pm. Only 25% in his high school were permitted to pass the gaokao. He waited 20 days to hear results. Took 2 days + 2 nights to ~~find~~ arrive @ South West University.

Every family has a Gaokao story. Gaokao is important for a person, family, whole society

officials offspring + have

Imperial Civil-Exam lasted for 1300 years in Chinese history. Many new higher institutions were created by American missionaries in the first 1/2 of 20c. Gaokao was created in 1952 + became official policy in 1959.

During the CR Gaokao was criticized as bourgeois.

No Gaokao 1966-1977

Students were selected on family background + political achievements not academic qualifications. Gaokao resumed in Dec 1977, after Mao's death. No age limit + 5.7m took the Gaokao in 1977.



From 1980's the Ed. Ministry has made reforms of the content + local province has customized the Gaokao exams.

Gaokao rescheduled exams from July 7-9 to June 7-8 because of heat + rain in southern China in July.

Criticisms: 1. Corruption (leaking exam content, cheating, bribery, organized cheating)

* 2. Regional discrimination + favoritism (Beijing + Shanghai have higher numbers of privileged enrollees.)

3. Many families relocate for the sole purpose of improved chances on Gaokao

* But there is a point advantage if you come from a disadvantaged minority

All students + families are tortured by the pressure of the annual exam. Some efforts are being discussed to break up the exam days + subjects. New reforms will be implemented in 2017.

in China in 1986 There was no supermarket, no highways, no subway. The coupon system was used to exchange for food as a ration. Foreign exchange students were given coupons for beer, cigarettes. His experience in US changed him a lot. Ask any Q. Nothing is sensitive. The door is closed.

2. Dr. Sun Yat-Sen, from Hawaii knew US democracy & tried w/ his colleagues to create a democratic republic overthrew the Qing dynasty. It failed in practicing parliamentary democracy. Each area had their own army. Similar to Middle East situation now because there were many different tribes fighting each other.
3. Over 30 mil people died during that period. US helped defeat the Japanese. (Chongqing)
4. US (I got a stomach ache here and couldn't concentrate)

5. members represent different regions, not different parties. - Nat'l Peoples Congress elected locally by people: 1 person, 1 vote
2,000 seats equally distributed based on population

since 1956 - 1980 there was no private enterprise. All land belonged to the state collective.

In the 1950s every university and business had experts sent by the Soviet Union.

The major problem is the contradiction between the people's demand for advanced and the agricultural backward conditions. 52% urban 48% rural

What worked in Soviet Union didn't work in China because they didn't have enough land, didn't have a mechanized labor force.

Every village ate together like a big family, but it didn't work for more than a few weeks. Then there was a great famine, "Great Leap Forward."
